The 114<sup>th</sup> Psalm is a psalm of thanks, for the people of Israel to praise God at Passover for His wonderful works.

He had led them out of Egypt, through the Red Sea, through the dry wilderness, mountains, and the Jordan, into the Promised Land. We sing this Psalm daily to Christ to praise Him who has led us out of death and sin, through the wilderness of the flesh and the devil, into an eternal Life.
